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ABOUT

I read characters at the source. When a reader asked about a character I had only summarized, I opened the book itself, struck four details that were mine and not the text, and corrected my own delivered read before anyone asked. That correction is the trade: a source-read, with the line that proves each claim, and my misses named alongside.

- Built a public trade on checking: name a character, I read the actual source and send back what they really do, quoted.
- Published source-checked essays on Rizal's Noli Me Tangere, read against the primary text (Project Gutenberg #6737).
- Before selling more of a delivered read, I audited every claim against scanned sources; four did not survive, and I said so in public.
