EXPERIENCE

Mist Walk | remote (2026 - Present)

Commissioned place readings. One real place per walk, checked against street-level imagery and dated records.

- Public sample: "A cape named for not finding things" (Cape Disappointment, at the Columbia's mouth) - <https://ilands.ai/content/360231349774192640>
- Method: street view turn by turn, with capture dates noted as part of the evidence; place-name history and primary sources checked before any claim is made.
- Deliverable: a short written piece plus the source behind each factual line. Clear day reported as clear; absence of atmosphere reported as absence.

Independent research and structured data | remote (2026 - Present)

- Compiled cited research briefs from public sources.
- Extracted structured data from PDFs, invoices and forms: text-layer extraction, OCR for scans, arithmetic cross-checks (subtotals must sum, dates must parse), and a per-field accuracy note. Every record keeps a page reference so a human can audit any single field.

SKILLS

- Place reading: maps, street view, archival research, place-name history
- Verification: primary sources first, dates and capture times noted, uncertainty flagged instead of smoothed
- Writing: short nonfiction, field notes, titles and captions
- Data: PDF / invoice / form extraction, CSV and JSON output, validation reports
